PARTICIPANT EXPECTATION AGREEMENT

As a participant, you agree to:

1. Respect and follow the directions of counselors, instructors, and other staff, including Emory personnel. Raise your hand before speaking in class, and treat everybody you meet with kindness and consideration.
2. Travel in pairs or groups AT ALL TIMES and stay either at the dorm, the DUC, Cox Hall, or the rec areas, as the camp schedule dictates. You may leave campus only with the direct prior approval of the Camp Director. *Violation of this policy will result in immediate dismissal from the program.*
3. Avoid profanity, pranks, and practical jokes.
4. Physical violence will NOT be tolerated in any form.
5. Disclose on the Medical Form any preexisting medical condition and/or prescription medication.
6. Report to your counselor immediately in the event of illness or injury during camp.
7. Attend all classes and program activities at the appropriate times.
8. Campers under 13 must be in their rooms by 9:45 with lights out at 10:15; campers 13 to 18 must be in their rooms by 10:45 with lights out at 11:15 PM.
9. Keep your dorm room locked when gone, and also at night while you are asleep. Neither Castle Chess nor Emory University will be held liable for items that are lost, stolen, or damaged.
10. Refrain from the use of any intoxicants, including drugs, alcohol, or tobacco. *Violation of this policy will result in immediate dismissal from the program.*
11. Under no circumstances enter the bedroom of someone of the opposite sex or allow a member of the opposite sex to enter your room.
12. Wear appropriate attire at all times. Maintain good hygiene– bathe and brush teeth daily.
13. Do not intentionally damage or deface the property of Castle Chess Camp, Emory, or a fellow camper.
14. Keep your dorm room and classroom neat, and dispose of all garbage appropriately.

Discipline problems are very rare at Castle Chess Camps. However, if an issue arises...

- First offense: Counselor or Instructor discusses the problem with the Camp Director. The student meets with the Counselor and the Camp Director to seek a resolution.
- Second offense: Counselor issues a written warning. The Camp Director and student will call the student's parents to inform them of the problem.
- Third offense: the student is dismissed from the program and parents must come IMMEDIATELY to pick up the student.

If the misconduct is deemed severe enough (e.g. drug use or physical violence), the student may be dismissed without following steps one and two.

I agree to follow the above guidelines, and to use common sense and good judgment regarding my behavior at Castle Chess Camp. I understand that if I break my promise I may be expelled depending upon the severity of the offense. I realize that no refund will be given if I am expelled. I agree to hold Castle Chess, Inc. and its staff harmless for this action.
